
I would also like to add thanks to all of us who support, volunteer and encourage our fellow RDAs, we are only as good as we are together.

In her spare time Corrine enjoys biking, swimming, skiing, and gardening!







We are entering into one of the busiest times of the year as the children return to school, register for activities, get their bi-annual dental checkup, and settle into yet another routine.

Your CDAA Board of Directors and CDAA Committees have been actively pursuing initiatives, and continuing to work on behalf of our profession.

2020-2023 Strategic Plan

We are half-way through our 2020-2023 Strategic Plan time-frames. The CDAA Board of Directors went through that document in August to ensure that we are on track and to make some minor adjustments to bring us closer to the goals that were set out in that plan.

Position Statement on Oral Health in Long-term Care

The CDAA's revised Position Statement on Oral Health in Long-term Care has been recently published and is available on the cdaa.ca website. Many thanks to our Research, Knowledge Transfer Committee volunteers for their work on this statement! This committee also responded to several requests for feedback from CRTC, Health Canada and Public Health on a variety of topics over the summer: Regulations Amending the Natural Health Products Regulations, Laser Emitting Device Regulatory Amendments, Mental Health 3-Digit Number, and Amendments Cannabis Flavours. Work has begun on a very important Position Statement on Regulation of Dental Assistants in Canada.

Bylaws and Governance Review

Our Bylaws and Governance Review Committee met to approve a Board Self-Evaluation document and they continue to work on the Board Orientation Package materials.

CDAA Committees

I want to strongly encourage you to consider serving on a CDAA committee in the coming year. These meetings are held virtually and provide an opportunity to work with other dental assistants who are dedicated to moving our profession forward throughout Canada. A few hours after work in the evening once a month or every two months are all the time that you need to contribute to the work of the CDAA and the benefits to you will be countless!



Introduction to Botulinum Toxin and Dermal Fillers in Dentistry

Saturday, April 2, 2022 | 9:00 AM - 12:00 PM

Injectable substances have been used to treat certain clinical entities as well as enhance cosmetic outcomes. Botox has been used both cosmetically and therapeutically to treat both the muscles of facial expression as well as the masticatory muscles in temporomandibular dysfunction. Understanding the injectable substance and the anatomy that it is being injecting into will aid in improving outcomes and help to prevent complications. Knowing the mechanism of action of the drug will help to educate patients so they can understand what the injectables can do, and more importantly, what their limitations are, Instructions on this aspect will be demonstrated as it improves clinical response. Injectables also include fillers and the lipolytic deoxycholic acid, Kybella. Scope of practice is dictated by provincial regulatory bodies that determine which professional group can administer those substances. These guidelines will be covered to determine practitioner eligibility in Manitoba.

At the end of the course, participants should be able to:

- Understand the therapeutic uses of Botulism toxin within the maxillofacial region
- Anatomic comprehension of where the injections are aimed and what structures to avoid
- Know the risks and complications of injecting Botox
- Have a basic understanding of other injectables
- Identify the commonly employed diagnostic and management strategies for white lesions of the oral cavity





e-Alert – September 28th, 2021

On Friday September 24, the Chief Provincial Public Health Officer released orders requiring vaccination or testing for designated persons effective as of 12:01 a.m. on October 18, 2021. At this time, categories of designated persons include the following:

1. Health care personnel

Persons who have direct contact with patients, residents and clients at:

- (a) hospitals;
- (b) northern nursing stations operated by the Government of Manitoba;
- (c) personal care homes or supportive housing facilities;
- (d) facilities operated by Shared Health Inc., a regional health authority, Addictions Foundation of Manitoba or a community services agency that are the subject of a funding agreement with Shared Health Inc. or a regional health authority;
- (e) a residential mental health facility or addictions treatment facility that is operated by or the subject of a funding agreement with the Government of Manitoba.

For certainty, this includes physicians, nurses, allied health professionals, health care aides, cleaning staff, support services staff as well as persons volunteering at those facilities who have direct contact with patients, residents and clients.

- 2. School personnel
- 3. <u>Licensed child care facility personnel</u>
- 4. Civil servants in direct contact with vulnerable populations
- 5. Child and family service personnel
- 6. Funded agency personnel in direct contact with vulnerable populations
- 7. Home care workers
- 8. Paramedics and emergency medical responders



All MDA members that fall in the categories of designated persons will be required to comply with the order. For full details see the Public Health Order:
